

# REMODELING COST GUIDE 2024

# Major Mid-Range Kitchen Remodel

A major mid-range kitchen remodel includes updating an outmoded 200-square-foot kitchen with a functional layout that includes 30 linear feet of semi-custom wood cabinets, including a 3x5-foot island, laminate countertops, and a standard double-tub stainless-steel sink with a standard single-lever faucet.

A new energy-efficient range, vented range hood, built-in microwave, dishwasher, garbage disposal, and custom lighting are added. New resilient flooring is installed, and the kitchen is finished with painted walls, trim, and ceiling.

# Major Upscale Kitchen Remodel

A major upscale kitchen remodel includes updating an outmoded 200-square-foot kitchen with 30 linear feet of top-of-the-line custom cabinets with built-in sliding shelves and other interior accessories. Stone countertops with an imported ceramicor glass-tile backsplash are added, along with a built-in refrigerator, commercial-grade cooktop and vent hood, wall oven, and built-in microwave unit.

A high-end undermount sink with designer faucets and water filtration system is installed. New general and task lighting, including low-voltage under-cabinet lights are added. Tile or similar flooring that looks like wood creates an upscale finish.

# Mid-Range Owner's Suite Addition

Add 24x16-foot owner's bedroom suite over crawlspace. Include walk-in closet/dressing area, freestanding soaker tub, separate 3x4-foot ceramic tile shower, and double-bowl vanity with solid-surface countertop. Carpet the bedroom floor; put tile in bath. Paint walls, ceiling, and trim. Install general and spot lighting, exhaust fan.

# Upscale Owner's Suite Addition

A 32x20-foot owner's bedroom suite is added over a crawlspace. There are custom bookcases and built-in storage with millwork details. A high-end gas fireplace with stone hearth and custom mantle, and a walk-in closet with natural light, mirrors, and linen storage are all included. The bathroom includes a walk-in shower with stone walls and floor, and a custom frameless glass enclosure. There's also a freestanding soaker tub, two sinks in separate custom vanities with stone countertops, and large mirrors. A partitioned area for a luxury one-piece toilet is added.

Soundproofing, in-floor heating, custom wall finishes and hardware, general and spot lighting, and high-end lighting controls are also included.

# Mid-Range Bathroom Addition

A mid-range bathroom addition is the same as a mid-range bathroom remodel except that it also accounts for new space, electrical, and plumbing.

# Upscale Bathroom Addition

An upscale bathroom addition is the same as an upscale bathroom remodel except it also accounts for new space, electrical, and plumbing.

# Mid-Range Bathroom Remodel

A mid-range bathroom remodel for this example involves updating an existing 5x7-foot bathroom. All fixtures are replaced, and a 30x60-inch porcelain-on-steel tub with a 4x4-inch ceramic tile surround and a new single-lever temperature and pressure-balanced shower control are added.

A new standard white toilet, solid-surface vanity counter with integral sink, and a recessed and lighted medicine cabinet are also added. The project is finished off with ceramic tile flooring and vinyl wallpaper.

Based on the Cost vs. Value report, here are your relevant facts & figures for a midrange bathroom remodel in the Northern Virginia area:

Total Estimated Cost: \$26,665

Resale Value: \$15,972Cost Recouped: 59.9%



# Upscale Owner's Bathroom Remodel

An existing 35-square-foot bathroom is expanded to 100 sf within the existing house footprint. Fixtures are relocated, and a 42x42-inch neo-angle shower including ceramic tile walls with an accent strip, recessed shower caddy, body-spray fixtures, and frameless glass enclosure are added.

A freestanding soaker tub with high-end faucets, a stone countertop with two sinks, two mirrored medicine cabinets with lighting, a compartmentalized commode area with one-piece toilet, and a humidistat-controlled exhaust fan are also installed. Larger matching ceramic tiles on the floor are laid on the diagonal with a ceramic tile base molding. General and spot lighting, including a waterproof shower fixture, are installed. Cabinetry has a custom drawer base and wall cabinets. HVAC is extended. Electric in-floor heating is installed.

# The Big Picture



# **Material Costs**

You'll pay more for flooring imported from overseas, top-of-the-line appliances, cabinets built to your specifications and other high-end features. Special orders cost more and may also extend your timeline if you must wait for them to arrive.

# **Project Length**

The longer the project takes, the more you'll pay for labor. If you're planning to renovate your entire home you may need to move out temporarily. Hotel or rental home fees will certainly increase your cash outlay.





# Labor

Whether you're adding a stained glass window to the living room or restoring a vintage staircase, you'll want to hire contractors with specific experience. # Plumbing and Electrical Costs

If you plan to move your kitchen sink or range, swap the location of your toilet and shower, or install heated floors or a steam shower, you may see an increase in the plumbing and electrical categories of your budget.


